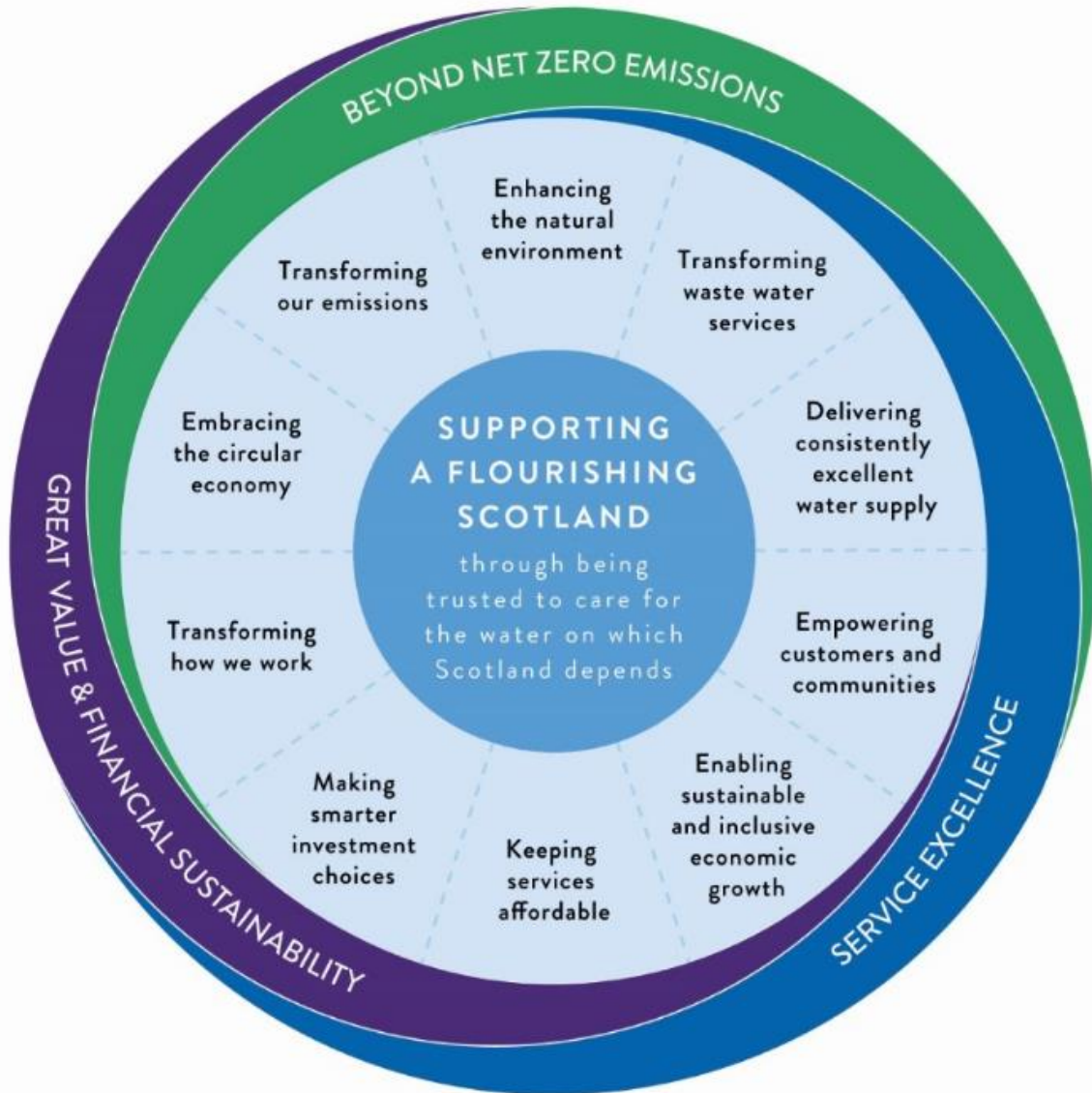

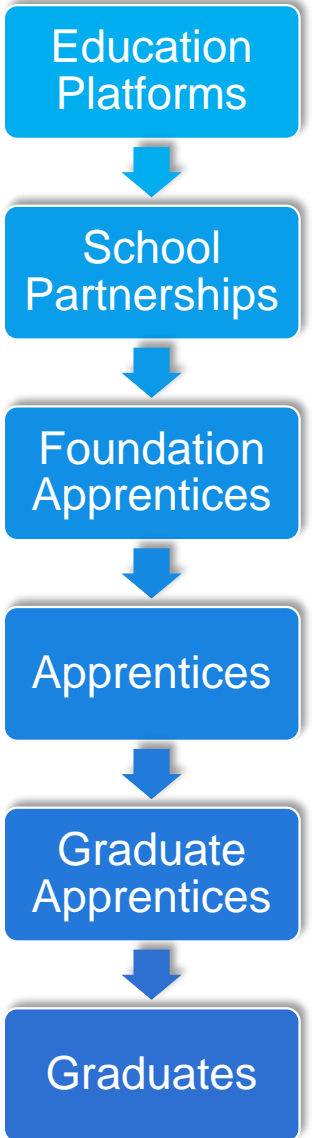


Our Purpose: Supporting a flourishing Scotland through being trusted to care for the water on which Scotland depends.
