## **BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES**

As the world's population is expected to reach nine billion by 2050, more water will be needed for farming, industry and personal consumption. A recent UN report predicts that by 2050, water demand will increase by 55%, and warns that the world may face a 40% shortfall in water supplies in just 15 years.

Against this background, the seminar aims to discuss the limits of our development model, while exploring political and management solutions that can reconcile our growth needs with the sustainable use of water resources. The specific contribution that public water operators can give to help tackle these immense challenges will also be considered.

Contributions from scientific experts and institutional representatives will feed the debate, with the additional aim of creating a thematic link between EXPO 2015 and the UN Climate Change conference, to be held in Paris at the end of 2015. Distinguished speakers have already confirmed their participation, including the Italian Minister for Agriculture, Mr. Maurizio Martina.
